STEM Work Experience Opportunity with National Grid. Happening 29 to 31 October at locations in London and the south-east and open to female students in Year 13 who are interested in engineering and technology (studying Maths and Physics at A-level). During the three-day programme, students will work alongside National Grid professionals, exploring potential STEM career paths and getting a behind-the-scenes look into the future of the energy industry.
